Maura Reilly: Hello. I'm Maura Reilly, Curator of the Elizabeth A. Sackler Center for Feminist Art. *The Dinner Party* by Judy Chicago, an icon of feminist art, represents 1,038 women in history—39 women are represented by place settings, and another 999 names are inscribed on the Heritage Floor, upon which the table rests. This monumental work of art is composed of a triangular table divided by three wings, each of which is 48 feet long. Arranged chronologically along the wings are 13 place settings; each includes a unique runner and plate, as well as a chalice, a napkin, and utensils.
