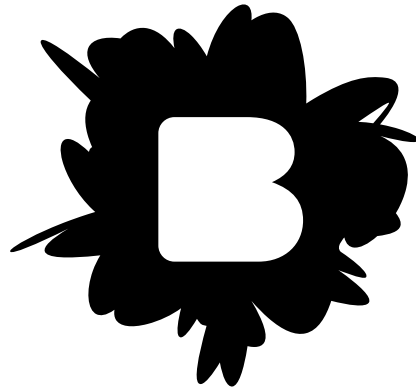

Drop-Off Hours for Scholarship Applications

August 25–September 10

Wednesday–Friday, 10 a.m.–5 p.m.

Saturday and Sunday, 11 a.m.–6 p.m.

Applications may be dropped off at the Visitor Center or in the Education Division, Gallery. Be sure to pick up a receipt for your scholarship application. **To find out if you have been awarded a scholarship, you must call the Education Division at (718) 501-6230 on Tuesday, September 16.** The Museum will not notify recipients; the responsibility to call lies with the applicant.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, applicants must submit this completed form along with the following items:

Statement of Interest

Describe why you would like to be a student in the Gallery/Studio Program and why you should receive a scholarship. You may ask someone to help you write this statement, but our expectations are age-appropriate, and we encourage you to write it yourself. Attach the statement to this application.

Letter of Recommendation

This should be a current letter describing the specific and distinguishing merits of the applicant. It cannot be written by a member of the Museum's staff or the applicant's immediate family. This letter will not be returned. Attach the letter to this application.

Portfolio

The portfolio is a package (a folder, envelope, or bag) of eight to ten works of art on paper. A variety of themes and media is recommended. No sculptures or framed pieces allowed. You may submit photographs of original works. Label the portfolio with the applicant's name and age. All portfolios, regardless of result, must be picked up September 16–30, or they will be discarded.

Letter of Financial Need (optional)

Applicants may include a letter from a parent, teacher, or counselor describing a financial need to be considered. Attach the letter to this application.
