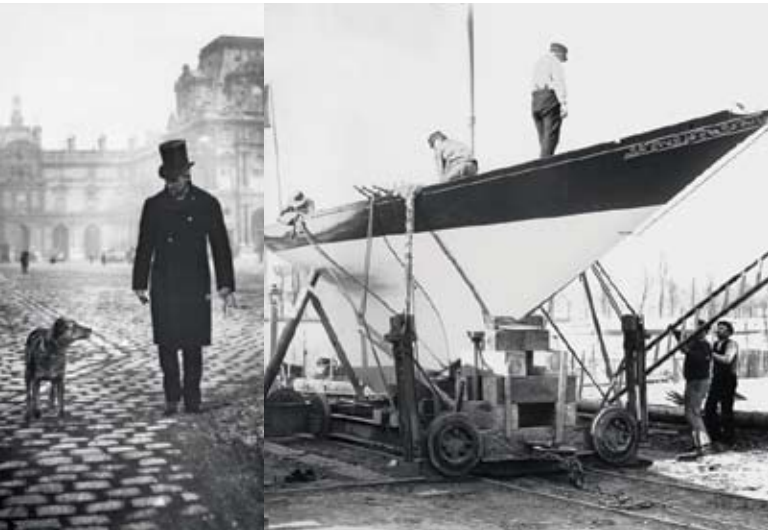


Eye Spy

Caillebotte (pronounced KY-a-bot) used many different colors of paint to show how water reflects light.

Find the painting that includes this detail. Look closely.

How many different colors can you find in the water? The next time you are outside looking at water, notice how many different colors you see.

Focus on: Color

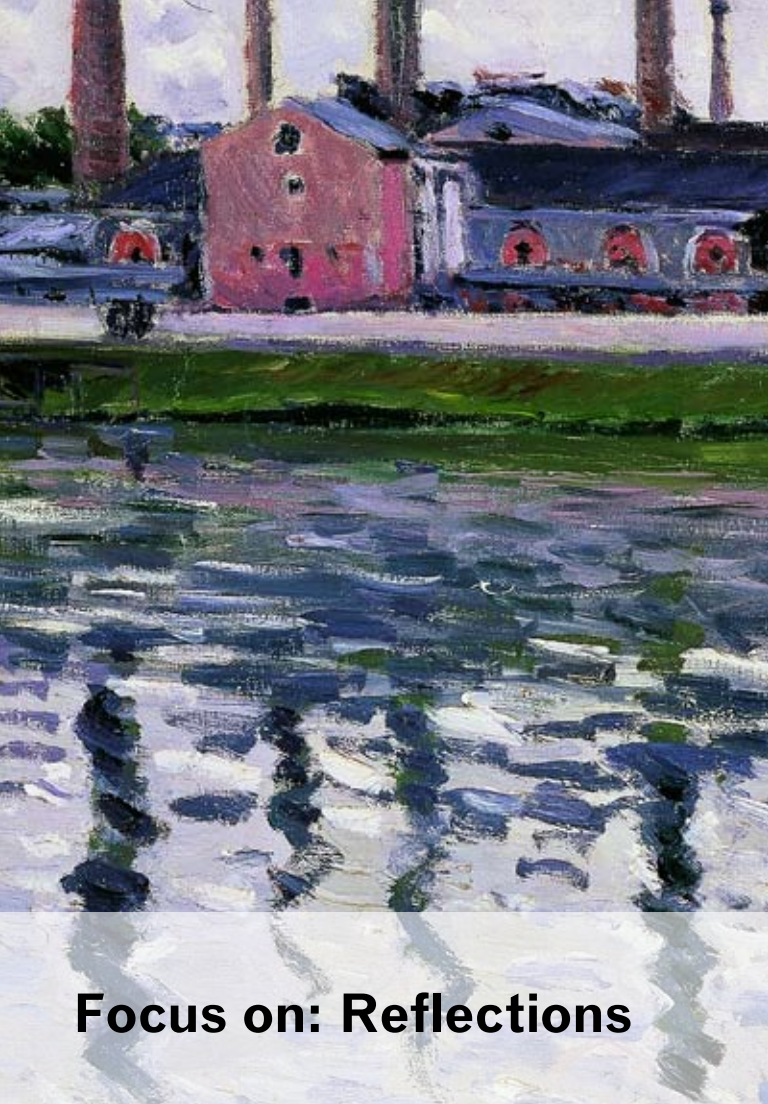


Caillebotte created his paintings with many different brushstrokes. Brushstrokes can help to show the water's texture, movement, and direction.

Find the painting that includes this detail. Look closely at the size and direction of the different brushstrokes.

In what direction might the water be moving? How can you tell?

Focus on: Brushstrokes



Caillebotte was interested in showing different ways that areas of water reflect the surrounding environment.

Find the painting that includes this detail. Look closely.

What do you see reflected in the water? Where can you find the colors in the sky reflected in the water? Look for reflections in other paintings.

Focus on: Reflections

Many of Caillebotte's artworks show people in pairs or in small groups.

Find a painting that shows at least two people. Look closely.

What are they doing? How do you think they might be feeling?

What do you enjoy doing with your friends or family?

Focus on: People together



Some artworks show people working while others show people playing or relaxing.

Find the paintings that include these details. Look closely.

What kinds of activities are people doing? What kind of activities do you see people doing in your neighborhood? How are they similar or different?



Focus on: People at work and at play

Caillebotte painted Paris, France, a large city where he lived more than one hundred years ago.

Find a painting that reminds you of a place in New York. Look closely.

What do you see that reminds you of New York? What do you see that is different?

**Focus on: Paris vs.
New York City**



Caillebotte painted people in the most up-to-date fashions from the 1870s, 1880s, and 1890s. Many of the people are wearing hats.

Find the paintings that include these details. Look closely.

Do the hats seem more fashionable or functional? What kind of hat would you wear today if you were doing that activity?

Focus on: Fashion



Caillebotte often painted people looking at the world around them. One of his artworks includes a dog that is watching something.

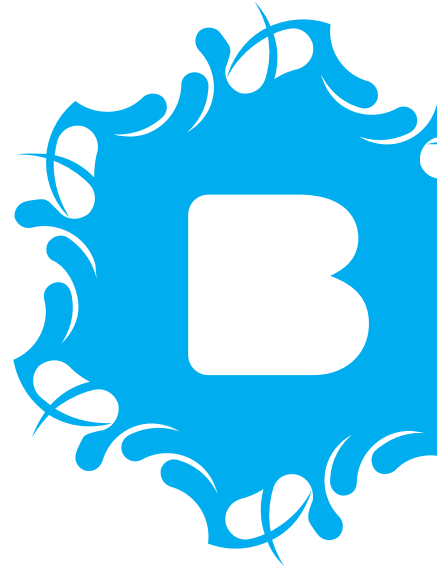
Find the painting with this detail.
