Brooklyn Museum of Art Announces Registration for Gallery/Studio Program Summer Sessions

The Brooklyn Museum of Art's **Gallery/Studio Program** offers fun and challenging studio art courses for children, age six and up, and adults. Through instruction in the galleries and in the studio, each course develops skills in viewing and creating art. Students increase their visual vocabulary, develop critical and analytical skills, and gain confidence in their abilities. Each two-hour class has eight sessions and includes instruction in painting, printing, drawing, sculpture, or mixed media. The July and August terms will meet on Wednesdays and Fridays for four weeks. The weekend term will meet on Saturdays for eight weeks. Class titles include: Dream Themes: Images on Paper; Investigating Form and Shape Through Clay; Summer Vacation: Traveling in the Museum; Drawing and Sculpting Comic-Book Art; Art: A Point of View; Working Small; and Painting Summer.

Registration takes place in June. Museum Members receive a \$15 discount and may register June 13 through 15. Registration for the general is June 20 through 22. The cost of the program is \$145. There are a limited number of scholarships available for students up to the age of seventeen. For more information about registration, scholarships, and class schedules, call (718) 501-6230.
