Brooklyn Museum of Art Announces Open Enrollment for Student Guide Program 2003–2004 Session

High school and college students who are interested in becoming Student Guides at the Brooklyn Museum of Art are invited to enroll now for the 2003 through 2004 session. BMA Student Guides participate in training that presents techniques for teaching adult groups in a gallery-based setting. With the help of experienced Museum Educators, Student Guides develop informal tours for the general public and are trained to talk about issues related to collections of the Brooklyn Museum of Art and art objects in general. Free studio art classes are also available as part of a work-study program. Work-study students assist a teaching artist in a class for younger students and attend an eight-session class free of charge. The BMA's Student Guide Program will meet Saturday at 3 p.m. from September 6, 2003 to June 7, 2004.
