Brooklyn Museum Announces Registration for Gallery/Studio Program Spring Semester 2005

The Brooklyn Museum's **Gallery/Studio** program offers fun and challenging studio art courses for students ages six to adult. Participants develop art skills through studying the Museum's collections and special exhibitions (including the retrospective of Brooklyn artist Jean-Michel Basquiat) and experimenting with a variety of materials and techniques such as drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture, and mixed media. Course themes for young people focus on sculpture, people, power figures, sketching from nature, and self-expression. Course themes for teens include writing as art, perspective, popular urban culture, and observational drawing and painting. Course themes for adults include experimental painting and works on paper. Each class has ten two-hour sessions. Spring semester classes are offered on Saturdays and Sundays. All levels of experience are welcome.

Registration forms and payment in full must be received (by mail, fax, or in person) by February 27. Early registration is encouraged, since classes fill up quickly. To obtain class schedules or registration, scholarship, or work-study applications, call (718) 501-6230 or visit the Museum Web site at www.brooklynmuseum.org/programs/educational_programs. Tuition is \$160 for Members, \$175 for non-Members and \$15 for scholarship recipients. Members receive priority handling, on a first-come, first-served basis, January 31-February 10. Registration forms for non-Members will be processed in the order in which they are received, February 14-27. In-person registration is available from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., February 11-13.

Scholarships are available for students ages six to eighteen (application deadline: January 23). Highschool students can apply for the Work-Study program (application deadline: January 23), in which students attend a **Gallery/Studio** class free of charge in exchange for assisting Museum instructors in classes with students ages six through nine.
